



5. Current Events!

Visa Pioneers New Payment Method

- Visa is launching a pay-by-bank/Account-to-account (A2A) system allowing consumers to transfer money directly from their bank accounts to merchants, bypassing the need for credit cards
- The service aims to offer enhanced security by eliminating the use of credit card details,
 reducing the risk of fraud
- Lower transaction fees are expected, benefiting both merchants and consumers
- It provides users with greater financial control, allowing for better budgeting and tracking of spending directly from their accounts
- Caveats: Launch is mainly intended for Europe and the UK starting in 2025 and success
 of this system depends on consumer adoption, security measures, and its integration with
 current payment systems



'Wall Street's Trash Contains Buried Treasure'



- Investors buying index-fund castoffs could have made 74 times their money since 1991 (NIXT)
- (Rob Arnott) <u>A paper he wrote in 2005</u> with Jason Hsu and Philip Moore helped ignite <u>the smart beta trend</u> that now guides more than one trillion dollars in assets
- Deletions have been historically traded at a 26% discount to S&P in terms of PE ratio, while additions fetch an 83% premium
- S&P 100 up 3x 1991

Arup Victim of a \$25M Deepfake Scam

- A worker in the HK office initially received phishing emails from the UK-based CFO, specifying the need for secret payments
- Got on a video call with the scammers and recognized the other people in attendance
- Sent 200M HK dollars (\$25M) to the scammers across 15 separate transactions
- Highlights the need for better KYC processes from banks
- Organizations need better payment security processes and playbooks to protect against sophisticated deepfake attacks
